

The Ray and Addy
Meyering Rifle Range
at Massawepie's
Camp Pioneer



Camp Background: The Otetiana Council, Boy Scouts of America, operates the Massawepie Scout Camps near Tupper Lake in the Adirondack Mountains of New York State to serve Boy Scouts from Rochester and Monroe County. In 2000, after a successful capital campaign, Camp Pioneer at Massawepie was extensively refurbished and reopened. Camp Pioneer now serves over 2100 Boy Scouts each summer.

Need for a new Rifle Range: A rifle range for teaching firearm safety is a standard part of the Boy Scout summer camp program. When Camp Pioneer was reopened in 2000, budget constraints prevented the construction of a rifle range. Since then, Scouts have been walking or getting rides to an old rifle range in the former Camp Mountaineer. The small size of this range, and its distance from camp, has prevented many Scouts from using the camp's safe shooting program.

The plan: A new rifle range will be constructed at the edge of Camp Pioneer. The new range will have 16 firing points, twice the capacity of the Mountaineer range. Construction will begin in 2003. The range is expected to be fully operational for the 2004 season, assuming adequate funds are raised for construction.

Naming: The new Camp Pioneer rifle range will be named for Ray and Addy Meyering, who are long-time Massawepie staff members.

Ray Meyering worked at the former Warren Cutler summer camp in Webster before Massawepie was purchased, and then worked on the 1952 Massawepie staff before becoming a New York State trooper. After retiring from the State Police, he became the Camp Forester rifle range director in 1980.

Ray has directed Massawepie rifle ranges each summer since then, at Camp Forester through 1994, then at Camp Mountaineer until the reopening of Camp Pioneer in 2000.

Addy has worked at Massawepie with her husband most summers since 1980, first in the Trading Post or Handicraft area and most recently assisting at the rifle range.

Ray and Addy have been associated for years with Troop 111 in Brockport.

How can I help? Donations are needed to cover the budgeted construction costs of \$90,000.
